



Citizen's Award Criteria

The Society has set up a ***Julio Good Citizen's Award***. The criteria for the Award are very simple and can be put into a mathematical formula:

$$A + A = D$$

Attitude + Action = Deed

It's the DEED that counts. The student's attitude is very important and the actions they take are useful and helpful in the community, making the community a better place to live, and may also make citizens recognize the positive things around them.

The Society recommends that nominations be submitted no later than May 1st of each year. Nominations for students, who would wish to include this award in their college applications, should be made prior to the student's senior year.

- Useful & Helpful in the Community (30%)

OTHER:

- Letter of Recommendation from teacher or project advisor (requirement)
