



Scholarship Criteria

The *Julio Helping Wing Scholarship* has been set up to assist students entering their first semester of higher education, unlike other scholarships that are not awarded until after the first semester is successfully completed. The student must have attained a high scholastic standing during their high school years, demonstrated community service, and have a family-financial need that qualifies under the state and federal requirements for low-income.

Applicants need to submit a letter describing why they feel they are eligible for the scholarship (no more than one typewritten page), a copy of their high school grade transcript that includes the most recent grades, a listing of community service/school activities they are involved in, a letter of recommendation from a teacher or other knowledgeable individual (other than a direct family member), a copy of the letter of acceptance from the school of higher education attending, and proof of family financial need (to qualify for state/federal low-income requirements), and submit it to The Julio Society, Savings Bank of Maine, 344 Main St., Calais ME 04619 to the attention of Dennis Brown, Exec. V.P. Applications must be postmarked by May 1st.

1. a letter describing why you feel you are eligible for this scholarship (no more than one typewritten page); please remember to highlight your community involvement
2. a copy of your high school transcript that includes your most recent grades,
3. a listing of community service/school activities you are involved in,
4. a letter of recommendation from a teacher or other knowledgeable individual, (other than a direct family member)
5. a copy of the letter of acceptance from the school of higher education
6. proof of family financial need (to qualify for State/Federal low-income requirements).

An incomplete application will not be considered.

If chosen to receive a scholarship, the Society must receive a copy of the enrollment form from the school of higher education before money is awarded to recipient.
